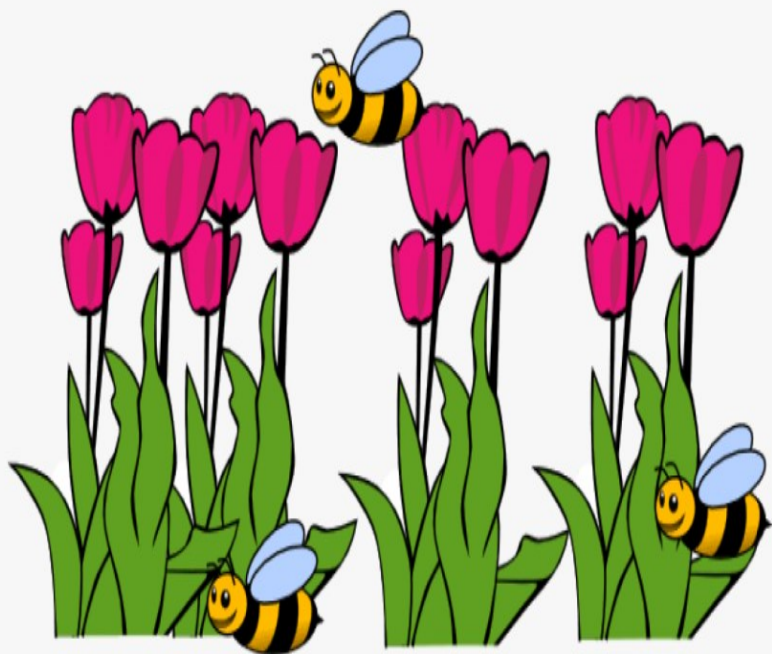


The American Red Cross will be holding a Blood drive on April 26 in the gymnasium beginning at 10:00 AM. Please consider donating blood!
