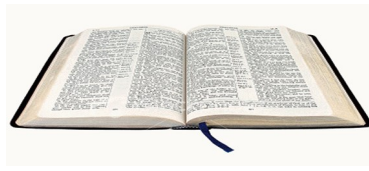

Dear Members, the council has been discussing the fire protection system upgrade project for the church facility and have come up with a plan to present to you for your approval. As you are aware, we discussed this project and the importance of the improvements during the congregational meeting along with the topic of the roof replacement. We have received an updated proposal for the fire protection system upgrade of \$25,625.00. We currently have \$4,995.00 in the collected funds thus far. That would leave approximately \$21,000.00 to be paid. We would like to use \$21,000.00 from the Undesignated Funds in order to have this project completed to assure the safety of the facility and our church family. On Sunday April 23, we will have a Ballot Vote - YES or NO on whether to use the Undesignated Funds. The ballots will be inserted in the bulletin. Please check your answer and then place the ballot in the receptacle at the back and front of the Sanctuary at the end of the service. Remember, **ONLY MEMBERS** can vote. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact any member of council. A copy of the proposal will be placed on the bulletin board in the hallway for your review.
