SPECIAL CONGREGATION MEETING

We will be having a “Special” Congregational Meeting on Sunday Morning February 11, 2024. The meeting will be brief and we will be seeking your approval of the Roof Replacement Estimate.

The vote will take place directly after Church and before Sunday School.

Following are the details of the estimate: The estimate includes shingles for the church and the pavilion. Also included is the necessary flashing and the “ice shield”. The install will be with all roofing nails no “staples”. If there are any necessary replacement of roof sheathing that would be extra. The total amount of the estimate is \$122,818.50. This includes a 2% discount for having the work done before the end of March 2024.

The contractor is S & R Roofing & Construction, LLC from Newburg, Pa. Samuel King, one of the principals of the Company was the contractor who installed our current roof over the Sanctuary in 2000. He was also the person along with his son who took time to provide the needed temporary repairs to the existing roof on the new addition.

A copy of the estimate will be located on the bulletin board in the hallway for your review.

In response to some folks who inquired about a metal roof: we obtained an estimate. The estimate for the metal roof would be \$361,000. If the roof would be installed by March 31 we would be able to obtain a 10% discount. The cost would still be nearly \$325,000.00.

If you approve the estimate we can then notify Samuel King so he can then order the materials and assure that the shingles are all manufactured in the same lot.
