**LOOKING AHEAD**

**Feb. 19** - 6:30 p.m.—Join us at Bible Study time as Pastor Runyan,  
Director of the Fruitbelt Farmworker Christian  
Ministry, will relate some of our history and share

about the work with the migrants during the last picking season. Pastor Runyan serves the migrant and seasonal farm workers who harvest apples, peaches and cherries. Most of the workers are single men who come without their families and live in migrant camps for the harvest season. A few of the workers remain in the area to help with pruning and other tasks. The service of FFCM includes supplying health kits, blankets and sweatshirts to newly arrived pickers, arranging churches to visit work camps, meeting emergency needs of pickers and Bible studies. This year is FFCM's 25th anniversary.
